

The case report requirement

- This reported case must be one of your own cases and you were directly involved the care of the patient.
- It must be in English and the style is Time New Roman font size 10-12 with minimum one page and no more than two pages.
- The case report should include the following
 - o Abstract
 - o History Presentation
 - o Physical Examination and Clinical Assessments
 - o Medical Decision Making
 - o Acupuncture Treatment
 - Outcomes, Discussions, and References

The case report is graded as follows:

Abstract

Brief description of the case.	5
Brief summary of the results.	5

History Presentation

Chronologically describe the case presentation history, which may include	
patient's age, gender, chief complaints, history of present history, pertinent past	15
medical history, social and/or family history.	

Physical Examination and Clinical Assessments

Examination toward the diagnosis may include vital signs, physical examination,	
pulse, tongue diagnosis, or other acupuncture related modalities if appropriate.	
You may also include laboratory findings, medical imaging results, or other	15
applicable medical evaluations. Use clear medical terminology to describe the	
clinical assessments.	

Medical Decision Making

Describe your rational for choosing a particular acupuncture paradigm(s). You	
may include your approach in therapeutic decision making and/or syndrome	20
differentiation diagnosis.	

Acupuncture Treatment

Explain the acupuncture treatment plans which may include style of acupuncture, acupuncture points selection, discussion of the points, methods of acupuncture,	
number and frequency of treatment. If appropriate, may include any other	20
available adjunct therapies.	

Outcomes, Discussions, and References

May use descriptive or measurable outcomes. Provide sufficiently detailed	
information that the outcome was response to acupuncture, and how likely that it	10
was due to other simultaneous treatment. Describe adverse events, if any.	
State what lesson can be learned from the case. Clearly describe any implications	
for clinical practice or medical research. Attempts should be made to find any	
related published or evidence-based literature. Carefully draw a conclusion the	10
association between your treatment and outcomes of the case. May include	
reference articles relevant to the case report.
